ORDER:

This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the Petitioner/Third Party/Owner of the vehicle (*Toyota Fortuner Car, bearing No.PY01-BZ-1122*) to quash the dismissal order in Crl.M.P.No.2026 of 2016 dated 16.09.2016 in Crime No.667 of 2016 of Rajendranagar police station on the file of learned VIII Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad at Rajendranagar for the offence under Section 409 of Indian Penal Code (for short "IPC").

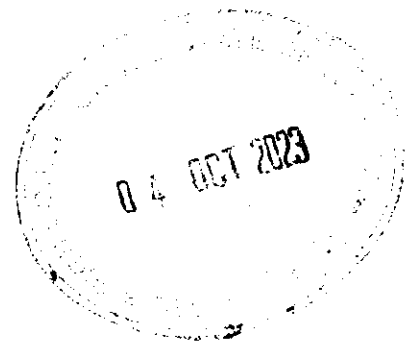
