ORDER:

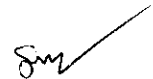

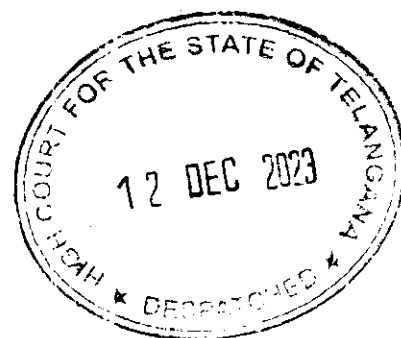
