This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), is filed by the petitioner Nos.2 & 3-accused Nos.2 & 3 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.168 of 2018 on the file of Women Police Station, Detective Department, Hyderabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code (for short 'I.P.C') and Sections 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act (for short 'D.P Act').

2. None appears for the petitioners. Perused the record.

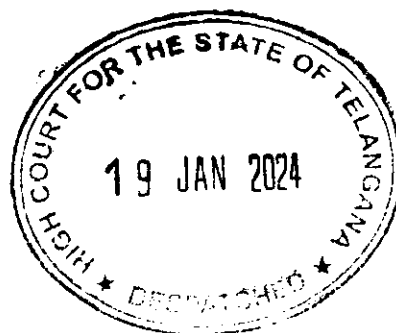
