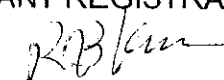

ORDER:

1. The present Criminal Petition is filed seeking the Court to quash the proceedings that are pending against the petitioner in Crime No.79 of 2018 of Women Police Station DD, Hyderabad.
2. No representation on petitioner's side on call.
3. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on written instructions, submits that on completion of investigation, charge sheet is laid and thus, the Criminal Petition has become infructuous.

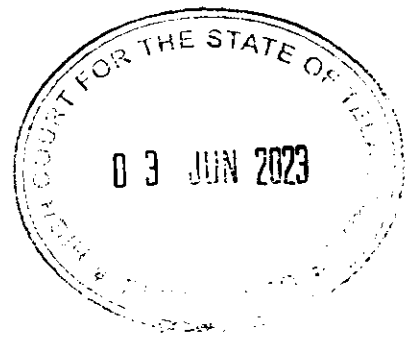
