Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in nature of writ of mandamus declaring action of Respondents 2 and 3 in proceeding with superannuation notice dt.06-04-2017 there by making petitioner to retire from service from 31-12-2017 without treating him on par with similarly situated employees whose services have been enhanced in pursuance of Circular.No.HRD/15 Dt.26-09-2017 as illegal, arbitrary and against principles of natural justice and consequently direct the Respondents 2 to 5 to continue the petitioner in service until he attains the age of 60 years by treating him on par with other employees whose superannuation age has been enhanced by Circular.No.HRD/15, Dt.26- 09-2017.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents 2 to 5 to consider the Representation dt.14-09-2017 on merits for continuing petitioner in service till he attains the age of 60 years by treating him on par with other employees whose superannuation age has been enhanced by Circular.No.HRD/15 Dt.26-09-2017.

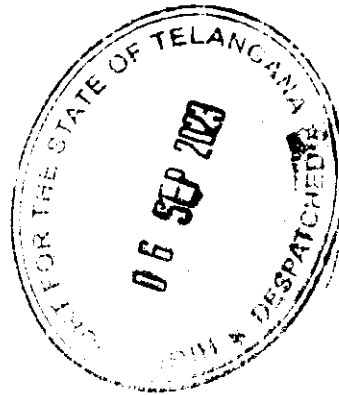
