This petition is filed for grant of interim regular bail as father-in-law of the petitioner expired on 31.12.2022 and there is no other male member in the family to perform the last rights.

Vide order dated 2.1.2023, the petitioner was permitted to perform the last rights of his deceased father-in-law on 3.1.2023.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, P.S. Rawal Pindi, Phagwara, submits that the factum of Bhog Ceremony is fixed for 11.1.2023 was verified.

It is also not being disputed that the petitioner is the son-in-law of deceased and there is no other male member in the family to perform last rites.

The petitioner is granted one week interim bail i.e. from 10.1.2023 to 17.1.2023 on furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. He shall surrender back to the jail authorities immediately after completion of one week interim bail i.e. from 10.1.2023 to 17.1.2023.

Disposed of.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
