Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.630 dated 03.12.2020, under Section 148, 149 and 302 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 32, 33 Karnal, in which, he has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the trial court as an additional accused.

2. On 06.01.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.630 dated 03.12.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302 IPC at Police Station Sector 32, 33 Karnal as the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the Trial Court as an additional accused to face trial.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. three persons were charge-sheeted and the petitioner was placed at Column No.2 and is now sought to be summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. He contends that no case for custodial interrogation is made out once the Investigating Agency has

found the petitioner to be innocent.

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to
surrender before the Trial Court and on his doing so he shall
be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Trial Court.*

3. In pursuance to the aforesaid order dated 06.01.2023, the petitioner has already surrendered before the trial court and has been admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction thereof.

4. The aforesaid fact has been verified by learned State counsel as well as Mr. Ranbir Singh, Advocate appearing on behalf of the complainant.

5. In view thereof, the petitioner having been submitted himself to the jurisdiction of the court and his bail bonds having been accepted to the satisfaction thereof, the petition is allowed. Order dated 06.01.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.
