Prayer in the petition is for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner on medical ground in case bearing FIR No. 124 dated 04.08.2021 registered under Sections 22 and 25 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Doraha, District Khanna for a period of 08 weeks to look-after his ailing mother who has been advised surgery.

Learned senior counsel submits that Balwinder Kaur-mother of the petitioner, is taking treatment from Satyam Multispecialty Hospital, Khanna, and she has been advised for surgery. The father of the petitioner has expired on 08.06.2005 and there is no one in the family to look after his ailing mother.

In compliance of the order dated 13.03.2023 passed by this Court, learned State counsel placed on the report of Deputy Superintendent, Sub-Division Payal, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, qua the medical status of the mother of the petitioner, in the Court. The report is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the treatment of the mother of the petitioner is going on from 09.11.2022 and that as per the aforesaid the certificate issued by Dr. Babita Abrol, MBBS, M.S. (Surgery), Satyam Multispecialty Hospital, Khanna attached with report, Balwinder Kaur- mother of the petitioner, is suffering from swelling genitalia and has been advised to undergo surgery according to her convenience.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the report and certificate issued by the Doctor.

It is a case in which the mother of the petitioner is suffering from swelling genitalia and her treatment is going on from 09.11.2022 and she was admitted to hospital on 20.11.2022 and she has been advised by the Doctor to undergo the surgery as soon as possible.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspect of the matter, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail for a period of 03 weeks, from the date of his release, on execution of the bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of the said period.
