It is submitted that the parties are in a live-in-relationship and fear harm at the hands of the private respondents, who are the close relatives of the girl. Thus, a representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted before respondent No. 2 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kanwarjeet Singh, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file reply.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the pending representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) after conducting an enquiry and by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Meanwhile, respondent No. 2 shall ensure that no harm is caused to the life or liberty of the petitioners.
