This is a petition filed under Section 439(2) read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for cancellation of bail granted to accused Amit Kumar @ Banti in FIR No.51 dated 11.02.2022 registered under Sections 384, 389, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Today, learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of an affidavit of DSP, Kaithal on behalf of respondent No.1 which is taken on record. Paras 3 and 4 of the same are reproduced here as under:-

“3. That in pursuance of order dated 11.01.2023, it is submitted that vide order dated 18.05.2022 the respondent no.2 had joined in the investigation on 11.06.2022. In this case respondent no. 2 offered to give demand draft of Rs.1,00,000/-

to the complainant. Keeping in view of said facts the interim order dated 18.05.2022 was ordered to be made absolute by this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 13.07.2022. The respondent no. 2 gave a demand draft of Rs. 1,00,000/- to respondent no. 3 which was handed over to the petitioner well in time.

4. That now a new demand draft no. 186663 dated 17.01.2023 of Rs. 1,00,000/- has been handed over to petitioner which was, vide memo dated 19.01.2023, received by him. The memo is annexed as Annexure R-1 for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the present petition and thus, seeks to withdraw the same.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
