The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.154 dated 04.05.2022 under Sections 323, 336 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act (earlier the FIR was registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act), registered at Police Station Division-B, Amritsar.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since the petitioner has been arrested during the pendency of the present petition.
