The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 60 dated 20.02.2020 under Sections 304-A, 279, 201, 427 IPC and Sections 304, 212 IPC added lateron, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P-4).

Pursuant to order dated 06.01.2023, report dated 16.02.2023 has been received from Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 60 dated 20.02.2020 under Sections 304-A, 279, 201, 427 IPC and Sections 304, 212 IPC added lateron, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
