By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.131 dated 09.12.2022 registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Bikram Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 06.01.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In pursuance of the afore-said order, learned State counsel has

also submitted the Short Reply (by way of the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City Batala, Police District Batala) regarding the medical condition of the petitioner and as mentioned in its Para No.4, the concerned Doctors had reported that the petitioner was suffering from several ailments as detailed therein.

4. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel and the contents of the Short Reply, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 06.01.2023, is hereby made absolute.

5. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
