The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0150 dated 27.09.2022 under Sections 406, 408, 467, 468, 471, 469 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 03.02.2023 and 22.02.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and surrendered his passport.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 03.02.2023 and 22.02.2023 and has surrendered his passport also. Therefore, he is not required for custodial interrogation .

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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 03.02.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
