The petitioner through instant petition under Section 407 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking transfer of case arising out of FIR No.104 dated 01.10.2021 under Sections 323, 498A, 34 & 406 of IPC registered at Police Station Gurugram, from District Gurugram to District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that he does not want to press his prayer qua transfer of trial from District Gurugram to District Ambala, however, prays that life and liberty of the petitioner may be protected from the hands of private respondents as and when she appears before the Trial Court for her examination.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to inform jurisdictional Station House Officer prior to the date fixed for her

examination and on doing so, the Station House Officer shall make sure that no harm at the time of her presence before the Trial Court is caused to her by private respondents.
