Learned counsel submits that by means of this writ petition, the petitioner prayed for quashing of the order dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P-16), whereby his appointment letter to the post of Dumper Operator (Trainee) was cancelled.

On 10.01.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:

“It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has submitted duly corrected certificate for his Category of EWS, as was required by the respondents. Still; the petitioner has not been offered the appointment as per his merit. The counsel has further submitted that otherwise also, even without the certificate, the petitioner is entitled to be considered in General Category and in General Category persons with 90 and 91 marks have been appointed. Whereas, the petitioner has secured 92 marks. Therefore, the petitioner is entitled to be appointed, by any means.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sudhir Nar, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and seeks time to file written statement.

Adjourned to 15.7.2022.

In the meantime, the respondents are directed to offer the appointment as per merit of the petitioner, but subject to the decision of the present petition.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the above order, the petitioner has been offered appointment and he has joined his service. According to him, the grievance raised in this petition stands redressed, therefore, he has instructions to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
