1. The petitioner, through instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to decide claim of the petitioner qua reimbursement of CGHS Medical Claim.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has made representations dated 29.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) 11.02.2021 (Annexure P-9) and thereafter served legal notice dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-10) for the redressal of his grievance qua reimbursement of medical expenses, however, respondent has not paid heed to the repeated requests of the petitioner.

3. Mr. Karan Kumar Jund, learned counsel for the respondents assures the Court that competent authority would pass a speaking order, adjudicating claim of the petitioner, within six weeks from today.

4. In view of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass speaking order qua representation of the petitioner within six weeks from today.

Disposed of in aforesaid terms.
