Status report filed by respondent- State in the form of affidavit of Mr. Harsimran Singh Bal, Deputy Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, as per which petitioner has joined the investigation but did not co-operate in the same, although learned counsel for the petitioner produced the copy of compromise which is taken on record.
