1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.01.2017 and 10.09.2013 passed in COCP-3346-2014 and in CWP-19945-2013, respectively.

2. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, as well as, the earlier proceedings which have been undertaken in this contempt petition, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition. Hence, the same is dismissed.

3. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise their claim before the appropriate Court in alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
