The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.37 dated 15.02.2022 registered under Sections 307/34 of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25, 25(1)(a) of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Charkhi Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

2. As per allegations, petitioner fired 3 shots at complainant Amarjeet on 15.02.2022.

3. Learned counsel contends that it is a no injury case. Petitioner is in custody for the last more than one year. Though charges have been framed but trial is likely to take long time to conclude. Learned counsel has also placed on record copies of the various orders in order to show that petitioner is on bail in all the cases as referred in reply of this petition.

4. Custody certificate has been placed on record by learned State counsel.

5. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail petition by pointing out towards the criminal antecedents inasmuch as petitioner is involved in as many as 19 cases referred in the reply.
6. To rebut the aforesaid contention, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in 6 cases petitioner has already been acquitted whereas in all other cases he is on bail.
7. Considering the fact that no injury was caused to the complainant and trial may take long time to conclude but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
