This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.454, dated 25.08.2022, registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hansi, under Sections 201, 204, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Sections 82 & 83 of Registration Act, 1908.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has undergone actual custody in excess of four months. There is no other criminal case pending against him except FIR No.136 which is under Section 174-A IPC. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not yet been framed. Thus, the petitioner may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes that charges have not yet been framed.

Keeping in view the period of custody undergone as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
