The petitioner/JD has approached this Court through the instant Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 14.12.2020 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurugram, whereby the petitioner/JD was directed to make payment of Rs.1,57,617/- and in default thereof, now conditional warrants have been issued against him vide order dated 24.12.2020 by the said court, which is also under challenge in this petition.
