1. Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 24.12.2019 (Annexure P-6), whereby, petitioners' claim for over time allowance has been declined. A direction has been sought to the respondents to release the said allowance.

2. Although writ petition has been contested by official respondents by filing response, but it has been submitted at the bar that controversy in dispute has been settled by this Court, vide judgment dated 26.04.2023 passed in CWP No.1067 of 2020 titled as '**Baljit Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**'. State counsel submits that said judgment may be challenged by the respondents by filing LPA.

3. Be that as it may, as the dispute has already been adjudicated by this Court by following an earlier judgment, writ petition deserves to be accepted in the same terms.

4. Accordingly, writ petition is allowed in the same terms as in CWP No.3005 of 2018 titled as ‘**Brij Bhushan and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**’, decided on 01.02.2019 (Annexure P-5). A direction is issued to the respondents to re-calculate the over time allowance on the revised scale and to pay differential amount to the petitioners within a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.
