Short reply dated 22.05.2023 by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar City on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 & 2 has already been filed.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out and referred to paragraph No.12 of the affidavit, wherein it is categorically mentioned that the petitioner and her parents were called by way of notice under 41-A Cr.P.C. by the investigating officer in case FIR No. 108 dated 15.04.2022 under Sections 341, 323, 427, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Amritsar (Annexure P-1), and, after verifying the facts during the course of investigation, the police did not find anything incriminating against her and her parents and as such they were relieved. It is also categorically mentioned therein that the petitioner and her parents do not have any kind of threat to their life and liberty at the hands of official respondents.

3. In view of the facts stated above, learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly made the statement, seeking withdrawal of the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file the same afresh, if so required in future.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
