The present petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Section 215 of the Code of Civil Procedure, praying for initiation of the contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating order dated 22.12.2015 passed in CWP 2884-2014.

Pursuant to the previous orders, counsel for the State has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 22.12.2015, passed in CWP 2884-2014, the case of the eligible persons, including the present petitioners was duly considered. Petitioner No. 1 was found entitled to the promotion and he has been promoted as such, whereas, petitioner No. 2 already retired before the consideration was done, and, therefore, he could not be promoted.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition and, accordingly, the same is dismissed. However, if the petitioners perceived any grievance of their to be surviving; then they or anyone of them would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
