The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing the FIR No.65 dated 31.7.2021 under sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, City-2, Abohar, District Fazilka along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this is a case of version and cross-version. He submits that with the intervention of respectables parties have amicably settled the dispute and the prosecution of the petitioners in the present case is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Grewal, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1-State and Mr. Harpal Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.2 to 7.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that investigation in the case is not yet completed.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, the investigating agency is directed to complete the investigation within a period of four weeks from today.
