Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.74 dated 20.06.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the case involves version and cross-version and as per cross-version opposite party caused grievous injury with sharp edged weapon to the petitioner. The counsel for the

petitioner further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardayal Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner has got effected recovery of the weapon used in the commission of crime. State counsel further submits that the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

As the present case involves version and cross-version, it is a matter of evidence as to which was the aggressor party. Further the recovery of the alleged weapon has been effected and petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 9.1.2023 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
