The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 read with Article 226 of the Constitution of India disposing of the main writ petition as having been rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the vehicle in question stands released and the loan account of the petitioner also stands closed and N.O.C. has been issued by the applicants-respondents.
