1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 15.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed in CM-15192-CWP-2016 in CWP-21095-2016.
2. Counsel for the State has submitted that the order has since been complied with, and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unaddressed, then they would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
