Prayer in the present petition is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in a complaint case dated 18.11.2022 bearing No.COMA-92015-2022 in case titled Superintendent (Anti-Evasion) vs. Ram @ Raman Chaggar, for the offence under Sections 132(1) (B, C & L) punishable under Sections 132(1)(I) of CGST Act, 2017 and under Clauses (B), (C) & (L) of sub Section (1) of Section 132 of Punjab State Goods & Services Tax Act, 2017 both read with Section 20 of the Integrated Goods & Services Tax Act, 2017.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the complaint is filed before the learned Magistrate and the medical report is also sought, however, the condition of the petitioner is serious and the medical report filed is not proper.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurabh Goel, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that the complaint is filed before the learned Magistrate and the medical report was also sought and the case is pending consideration for 17.01.2023.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Magistrate concerned to appreciate the

arguments raised by learned counsel for the parties especially the petitioner, who has alleged that the medical condition of the petitioner is serious and he needs to be examined in PGI. The learned Magistrate would seek report from the Jail Authority and if so warranted, he would direct the petitioner to be examined in PGI as well and ensure that the petitioner is provided the requisite treatment.
