The prayer in the present petition under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. is for cancellation of bail of respondent No.2 in FIR No.67 dated 29.08.2019 under Sections 341, 323, 355, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 295 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur granted by this Court vide order dated 25.08.2020 (Annexure P-2).

On 01.02.2022, notice of motion was issued, pursuant to which, the respondent-State and the accused No.2 have submitted their replies. A perusal of Para 7 of the reply dated 16.10.2023 filed by way of an affidavit of Davinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla, would show that preventive action has been

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(respondent No.2) son of Gurmeet Singh and the petitioner-complainant Daljit Singh Sond son of Gurmail Singh vide DDR No.35 dated 03.03.2022, Police Station City Ahmedgarh.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court at this stage. Therefore, the present petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that in case respondent No.2, at any later stage, attempts to threaten the petitioner or any other witness, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court once again by way of an appropriate petition in accordance with law.
