The petitioners allege violation of the order dated 04.04.2016 passed in CWP-3763-1998, vide which the parties were directed to maintain status quo with regard to alienation and change of nature of land in question till further orders.

Reply by way of affidavit of SDM-cum-Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur is on record and in para No.3 thereof, it is stated that before passing the order dated 04.04.2016, respondent No.2 had executed two sale deeds dated 28.03.2016 in favour of respondents No.3 & 4 and mutation No.27676 and 27677 were entered by the Patwari Halqa with a note in red ink that the case is pending before this Court. On objection raised

on behalf of the petitioners, mutation is declared contested and is referred to Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Garhshankar.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4 submits that mutation proceedings are kept in abeyance by the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Garhshankar to await final outcome by the writ Court.

In view of the above, no willful disobedience is made out.

Dismissed.
