Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.84 dated 04.07.2022 registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 427, 323, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Allegations are that on 03.07.2022 at about 05:30 P.M., petitioner along with various others assaulted Ravinder Kumar alias Ravi and caused injuries to him with an intention to kill him.

As rightly contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that only two injuries were noticed in the MLR. Injury No.1 is an incised wound on the left hand wrist whereas injury No.2 is in the form of abrasion on right hand middle finger.

It is conceded by learned State Counsel that none of the injuries were found to be grievous. However, Section 307 IPC has been inserted as the petitioner was having intention to kill the complainant.

Having noticed the aforesaid facts, I find it to be a fit case to grant regular bail as trial may take time, therefore, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this bail petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds

and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/ learned
Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
