1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondent as he has not complied with the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 02.07.2014 (Annexure P-1).

2. Keeping in view the facts available on the file, as well as, the reply filed by the respondent, this Court does not find it appropriate to proceed further in the contempt petition. Hence, the same is dismissed.

3. However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved of any alleged non-compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, and is having any other right qua that alleged violation, he would be at liberty to raise the issue before an appropriate Court in appropriate proceedings.
