The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs. 20,78,436/- including security qua the works executed by the petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was allotted work of Construction of New-in-take Water Chamber to supply Drinking Water for SAS Nagar Mohali and Chandigarh from Kajauli Head Works vide work order No. 48 dated 30.08.2018 for an amount of Rs. 69,52,960/-. The petitioner was successfully executed the said work on 15.03.2020. The payment of three running bills has also been

released to the petitioner but the payment of 4th & final bill amounting to Rs. 19,60,789/- including security has not been released to the petitioner. He contends that the petitioner is also entitled for an amount of Rs. 1,17,647/- on account of 6% GST rate difference. However, the total amount payable to the petitioner comes to Rs. 20,78,436/-.

It is contended that the bill with respect to the aforesaid work has already been sent to the respondent-authorities and various representations including Legal Notice dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) has been made by the petitioner to the respondent No.4-the Executive Engineer, Bhakhra Main Line Division, Patiala for release of due payment.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case the respondent No.4-the Executive Engineer, Bhakhra Main Line Division, Patiala is directed to look into the Legal Notice dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents and has no objection in the event such prayer of the petitioner as aforesaid is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with consent and without commenting on the merits of the claim, with a direction to respondent No.4-the Executive Engineer, Bhakhra Main Line Division, Patiala to examine the grievance espoused by the petitioner in the Legal Notice dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon within a period of 03 months of the receipt of

certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

Needless to mention that in the event any amount is found payable, the same shall be released forthwith and preferably within a period of 03 months of such a decision being taken by the respondent-authorities.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
