The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a case FIR No.482, dated 15.12.2022 under Section 346 of IPC, Police Station Cheeka, Kaithal has been registered against the son of the petitioners and now the police officials are trying to arrest their son. However, the petitioners had no concern with the allegations leveled in the said FIR and the police officials are trying to harass them and they visit them frequently and misbehave with them. Even the petitioners were confined in the lockup without any fault on their part.

On advance notice, Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance and submits that initially, the FIR was registered under Section 346 IPC and now the offence under Section 302

IPC has been added after investigation and the petitioners have been questioned as per law as their son, who is the accused in the said FIR is missing. He however, submits that due procedure of law shall be followed in the investigation of the said case. He further submits that in case the petitioners are to be questioned or interrogated, the investigating Agency shall follow the process as established by law.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the State, no further orders are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
