Compliance affidavit of the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal is filed today in Court, wherein, it is stated that on 02.05.2023, SDM, Kalayat appointed Naib Tehsildar, Kalayat as Duty Magistrate and after conducting an inquiry, the peaceful possession of the land in question, measuring 105 Kanal 14 Marla, was delivered to the petitioners. It is further stated that the statement of respondent Nos. 3 and 4 was also recorded as per their duly sworn in affidavits.

At this stage, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2, on instructions from respondent Nos. 1 and 2, who are present in Court, submits that till the decision of RSA-846-2007, wherein *status quo* has been granted vide order dated 10.07.2008, they will not interfere in the possession of the petitioners. It is further submitted that they have submitted

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affidavits in this regard to the police.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 further submits that since the possession of the land in question has been handed over to the petitioners, respondents/contemners be not awarded any further punishment.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2.

Since respondents have undertaken to abide by the orders passed by this Court in aforesaid RSA and not to interfere in the possession of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of as no further action is called for.

Rule stands discharged.
