AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Appellant No.1-Raj Kumari and appellant No.2-Dharminder have appeared in person. They have placed on record photocopies of their Aadhar cards and further, they are identified by Mr. Devi Lal, Advocate. He has also placed on record his identity card issued by the Bar Council of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh. Both the appellants state that Mr. Gunu Parshad father-in-law of appellant No.1 died on 10.07.2005. A perusal of record indicates that none has come forward to get impleaded as his legal heir. After discussion, it was stated by both the appellants, named above that in case respondent No.3-Insurance company is ready to make payment of an amount of Rs.4,50,000/- over and above the amount already paid by learned MACT, then this appeal can be disposed of.

Mr. Vinod Gupta, Advocate and Ms. Charanjeet Kaur, Deputy Manager, representative of respondent No.3-Insurance company, on getting instructions from Insurance company, accept the proposal made by the appellants. Appellants further state that in case any claim is raised by any other person being legal heir of appellant No.3, they shall indemnify the said person to the extent of share of Gunu Parshad.

In view of above facts, appeal stands disposed of and, it is ordered that an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- be disbursed in favour of appellant No.1-Raj Kumari wd/o Sh. Rama Kant Giri and Rs.1,50,000/- be disbursed in favour of appellant No.2-Dharminder son of Sh. Rama Kant Giri with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 05.10.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this

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order. On receipt of cheques, the Registry will make a call to both the appellants to their mobile numbers i.e. 8077709871 (Raj Kumari) and 9318418033 (Dharminder) and intimate them to collect the cheques. Cheques will be issued to them on verifying their identity proof. The statements of the appellants and their counsel has been recorded, which is placed on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
