Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.410 dated 09.11.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 379, 427 IPC (Section 379 IPC removed and Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

On 20.02.2023 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute which is the subject matter of the FIR in question stands settled between the petitioner and the complainant.

Adjourned to 16.03.2023.

Before the adjourned date the State shall verify the afore assertion made on behalf of the petitioner.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.410 dated 09.11.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 379, 427 (Section 379 IPC removed and Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. ”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that the State no longer requires the petitioner for investigation purposes.

In the light of the statement made on behalf of the State and that the dispute between the petitioner and the complainant has been settled, subject to the petitioner's abiding by the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C the order of this Court dated 20.02.2023, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
