The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing FIR No.211 dated 19.11.2022 registered under sections 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC at Police Station, Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that petitioner is a student and his future is at stake. He fairly submits that after registration of the FIR matter has been amicably settled between the parties and prosecution of the petitioner in the present FIR is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.
