Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the letter dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) and order dated 08.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), whereby, the petitioner has not been granted the benefit of extension in service after 58 years being physically disabled to the extent of 60% as per the letter dated 23.01.2018 (Annexure P-12).

Copy of Disability Certificate dated 03.03.2023 issued by the Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh pursuant to order dated 28.02.2023 passed by this Court, has been placed on record

by counsel representing U.T.Chandigarh.

Disability of the petitioner has been assessed as 25%.
