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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 15.12.2022 registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 225, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

(2) On 22.02.2023 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Status report filed by the State in Court today is ordered to be taken on record.

For arguments, adjourned to 26.04.2023.

Seeking ad-interim anticipatory bail, learned counsel for the petitioners inter-alia submits that the petitioners are the parents of Gurjant Singh who have been falsely implicated in this case at the behest of the police; even if the case of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, no specific injury is attributed to either of the petitioners and that the petitioners are ready and willing to join and cooperate with the investigation.

After considering the afore submissions, as an interim measure, it is directed that subject to the petitioners' joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of their arrest in FIR No.55 dated 15.12.2022 registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 225, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga, they shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

(3) Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation and that the State no longer requires the petitioners for investigation purposes.

(4) In the light of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners as have been recorded in the afore quoted order as also the statement made on behalf of the State, subject to the petitioners’ abiding by the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C the order of this Court dated 22.02.2023, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is ordered to be made absolute.
