This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 for conducting fair and impartial investigation/inquiry of case FIR No 149, dated 21.12.2022 under Sections 353, 186 and 379 of IPC and offence under section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation Act, 1957) registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana (Rural) (Annexure P-1). Further prayer is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to decide representation dated 30.12.2022 (Annexure P-10) within a stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the representation dated 30.12.2022 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2 has not been decided till date and submits that he would be satisfied if the said representation is decided within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG Punjab who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents i.e. respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh submits that the

respondent-State will look into the matter within a stipulated period.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioner, after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
