[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the adjournment prayed for before the learned trial court was on account of the learned arguing counsel representing the petitioner having gone abroad till 15.01.2023, to enable arguments to be advanced before the learned trial Court. Learned Counsel further prays for grant of one opportunity to address arguments on such terms as deemed just and proper otherwise grave prejudice would be caused to the petitioner.

[2] Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 and 2 only.

[3] Mr. Maninder Singh Saini, Advocate puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of contesting respondent Nos.1 and 2. He on instructions from respondent Nos.1 and 2 states that they have no objection to the prayer for a short adjournment to enable counsel for the petitioner before the learned trial Court to address arguments subject to payment of costs on one date and that too within a reasonable period of time.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement

of learned counsel for the parties, impugned order dated 04.01.2023

passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Phagwara is set aside and the instant petition is disposed of by requesting the learned trial Court to adjourn the matter listed before it for 11.01.2023 to 27.01.2023 on which date, learned counsel for the petitioner would address arguments on behalf of the petitioner before the learned trial Court subject to payment of costs of Rs.7,000/- to respondent Nos.1 and 2 while making it clear that no further date would be sought nor granted for the purpose of addressing arguments and in the eventuality of the petitioner not addressing and concluding arguments on 27.01.2023, no further opportunity shall be granted and the learned trial Court would be at liberty to proceed in the matter, in accordance with law.
