1. This is second petition filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 70, dated 22.7.2020, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Smalsar District Moga.

2. The main thrust for seeking regular bail is on the ground of custody period.

3. Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singhs submits that only one prosecution witness (police official) is remained to be examined and an earnest effort would be made to examine the prosecution witness on the next date of hearing i.e. 22.7.2023.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner is not pressing the petition at this stage.

5. Dismissed as not pressed.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

7. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
