MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent(s) to pay the amount of compensation along with interest for the remaining 14 Marla of land.

On 15.03.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned State Counsel, while making reference to para 3 of the short reply dated 12.08.2021, has pointed out that for the acquired land, compensation has already been paid and so far as remaining 14 Marla is concerned, the same stands de-notified on 01.03.2021 (R-2/1).

Since no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioners, purely in the interest of justice, posted on 24.03.2023.

Be shown in the urgent list.”

Today, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioners acknowledged that the aforesaid land, measuring 14 Marla, has been de-notified by the Government on 01.03.2021.

In view of the above development, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that present petition be disposed off with liberty to take recourse as per law, if the occasion so arises.

Disposed off accordingly.
