The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.154 dated 26.06.2021, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 406, 420 & 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over 05 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as even charges have not been framed as yet. There is no other criminal case pending/decided against the petitioner and thus, she may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 19.03.2023 digitally signed by Sh. Varun Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Yamuna Nagar has been submitted in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 07 days and there is no other criminal case pending against her.

Learned State counsel concedes that charges have not yet been framed.

It is thus, evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. The petitioner has clean antecedents and has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 07 days. Keeping in view all these facts cumulatively, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
