TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA J. (ORAL):

This petition has been filed for initiating contempt proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, against the respondent for not passing appropriate order in terms of judgment/ order passed by the learned Single Judge in CWP No. 2094 of 2007, *Hanuman Singh v. State of Haryana and others*, affirmed by the Division Bench in LPA No. 160 of 2010, *State of Haryana and others v. Hanuman Singh and another*, as directed by this Court vide order dated 19.3.2014 passed in CWP No. 21686 of 2008 titled *Rajinder Kumar v. State of Haryana and others*.

2. A perusal of the order dated 19.3.2014 (Annexure P-3) shows that vide this order, writ petition was disposed of by directing the respondent/State of Haryana to decide the grievance of the petitioner in terms of the judgment passed by the learned Single Judge and affirmed by Division Bench in LPA No. 160 of 2010 of even date, within one month.

3. A perusal of the reply dated 5.1.2016 shows that in compliance

of the directions dated 19.3.2014, a detailed speaking order dated 9.9.2014 rejecting the petitioner's claim, was passed by Additional Director of the Department being the appointing authority. The same was challenged by the petitioner by filing CWP No. 24291 of 2015 titled *Rajinder Kumar v. State of Haryana and others*. Since the directions issued by this Court to pass a speaking order stand complied with, there is no intentional violation of the order dated 19.3.2014.

4. In view thereof, there is no ground to proceed against the respondent.

5. Disposed of.

6. Rule stands discharged.
