Vide order dated 29.03.2023, learned State counsel submitted that though the petitioner has joined investigation, but was not co-operating as recovery of Rs. 1,00,000/- and one passport was yet to be effected.

Today, Mr. Vishal Thakur, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant, filed his power of attorney which is taken on record. As per order dated 10.01.2023, reference to the statement of the complainant was made where it was categorically stated that no financial transaction has taken place between him and the petitioner for sending his family abroad.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not have any objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and without commenting on the merits of the case and order dated 10.01.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
