SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Present appeal has been filed by the appellant under Section 14-A of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, against impugned order dated 19.12.2022, Annexure P-2, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, whereby application moved by the applicant under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed.
2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Lakhwinder Singh, State counsel submits that the appellant has joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
3. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, appeal is allowed and impugned order dated 19.12.2022 is set aside. Order dated 09.01.2023 is made absolute subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
